3. What are cookies?

Overview

3.1. Cookies are small text files which are placed and stored on your computer, mobile or other device when you first visit a website. Cookies will be used to help the Platform work effectively and efficiently.

Types of cookies

3.2. Source of cookies

- First party cookies cookies we set on the Platform.
- Third party cookies cookies set by other companies on the Platform.

3.3. Categories of cookies

- **Strictly necessary cookies** cookies that are essential for operation, and your use, of the Platform.
- Functionality cookies cookies that help to recognise you and improve the functionality of the Platform.
- Analytical cookies cookies that collect information about your use of the Platform and monitor the performance of the Platform to help our service providers to improve performance, the services provided through the Platform and your experience of using it.

3.4. Duration of cookies

- **Session cookies** cookies that start working when you access the Platform and stop when you log-out.
- Persistent cookies cookies that stay in one of your browser's subfolders until your browser deletes them (based on the duration period of the cookie) or you manually delete them.

The following third-party cookies will be used on the Platform.

 - when we need to obtain your consent to store cookies on your devices for non-essential cookies, we will request this and if you do not consent to cookies we will not use these cookies.
- **5.2.** Please note that some the Platform functionality, including the chat support functionality, may not be available to you if you restrict or disable cookies.
